



Somerset State Basketball – Policies & Terms

1. Membership & Payments

- All sessions operate on a monthly subscription basis.
 - Payments are collected on the 1st of each month via our booking system.
 - Your space at sessions is secured through an active subscription.
 - Failure to maintain an active payment may result in your space being released.

2. Cancellation & Notice Period

- We require one month's written notice to cancel your subscription.
 - Upon notice, your final payment will be taken on the next scheduled billing date (1st of the month).
 - Players are welcome to attend all sessions during their notice period.

3. Non-Payment

- If a payment fails, we will attempt to contact you to resolve the issue.

- If payment is not received following this communication, your child will be removed from the session register and will not be able to attend.
 - Spaces may then be offered to other players on our waiting list.

4. Injuries & Illness

- If a player sustains an injury during one of our sessions that results in two or more weeks out, we will pause your subscription accordingly.
 - If a player is injured outside of our sessions, any request to pause or cancel may result in the loss of that player's space within the programme.
 - Due to high demand, active, paying members are prioritised for places.

5. Drop & Go Policy

- All sessions operate a "drop and go" policy.
 - Parents/guardians are expected to drop players off and return at the end of the session unless a designated viewing/seating area is provided.
 - This ensures a focused, safe, and high-quality coaching environment for all participants.

6. Parent & Spectator Conduct

- We pride ourselves on delivering a positive and professional environment.

- Any disruptive or inappropriate behaviour from parents/guardians may result in the withdrawal of the player's place within our sessions.

7. Player Behaviour Expectations

- We expect all players to show respect to coaches, other players, and the environment.
 - Somerset State Basketball operates a clear behaviour system, and persistent disruption may result in removal from sessions.

8. Personal Belongings & Valuables

- Players are advised not to bring valuables, including mobile phones or electronic devices, to sessions.
 - Somerset State Basketball accepts no responsibility for loss, theft, or damage to personal items.

9. Attendance & Punctuality

- Players should arrive on time and ready to participate.

10. Health & Safety

- All injuries, no matter how minor, will be communicated to parents/guardians at collection.
 - Where required, a first aid form will be completed and signed.
 - By attending sessions, you confirm that your child is fit to participate in physical activity.

11. Session Changes & Cancellations

- In rare circumstances (e.g. venue availability, weather, or unforeseen issues), sessions may need to be rescheduled or relocated.
 - We will always aim to provide as much notice as possible and communicate clearly with all members.
